Lecturer Position**

The Department of Comparative Literature at Indiana University Bloomington is seeking applications for the position of Lecturer. This full-time position will begin in August 2021. The successful candidate will teach 2 undergraduate courses per semester, supervise popular culture classes taught by graduate students, and perform service work in the department. The initial contract is for three years with reappointment considered annually and the possibility of promotion to senior lecturer and long-term contract in the sixth year. Salary commensurate with experience.

Requirements: Completed PhD in comparative literature or a closely related discipline; knowledge of multiple literary traditions in two or more languages; expertise in popular culture and intermediality; extensive teaching at the undergraduate level; experience in supervising graduate student instructors.
